The Russian River Valley Pinot Forum began in 2003, with a mission to educate fine wine buyers from all over the world about the distinctive characteristics of Pinot Noirs and winemakers of California's Russian River Valley. It consists of three days of seminars both in the field and at tastings that afford guests an in-depth knowledge of how and why the Pinot Noirs of the Russian River Valley are distinctive. Cutting-edge winemakers address the history of the region, terminology and terroir of our special corner of Sonoma County, California. Twenty of the region's top winemakers host the Pinot Noir-focused "boot camp" for 60 top on-premise wine buyers and sommeliers from core wholesale markets around the country, including AZ, CA, CO, DC, FL, GA, IL, NV, NY and TX. The 3-Day Education Camp comparative set tastings hosted by Master Sommeliers & Masters of Wine, vineyard tours, winery tours, luncheons, dinners, and lots of quality time mingling. With only 60 sommelier buyers and 20 winemakers, the opportunity to spend quality one-on-one time with winemakers is unparalleled.
